Resolution approving the Revised Fiscal Year 2012- 2015 Transportation Improvement Program:

WHEREAS, the Cumberland Area Metropolitan Planning Organization was established to manage and provide policy direction to the Unified Planning Program in accordance with Federal requirements, and the Allegany County Commissioners have been designated as the Metropolitan Planning Organization for this area as approved by the Maryland Governor Harry Hughes on May 17, 1982; and

WHEREAS, the staff of the Maryland Department of Transportation and the Allegany County Department of Community Services, have together prepared the Transportation Improvement Program for Fiscal Year 2012 – 2015 in compliance with applicable Federal programs and regulations; and

WHEREAS, project 09-5 (Areawide Resurface and Rehabilitation) is to increase FY 2014 funding to \$13,000,000.00 and FY 2015 funding to \$3,000,000.00; and


