

## PLASTIC BOTTLES & JUGS

-  Clean soda, water, juice bottles
-  Clean milk, laundry detergent, cleaning supplies, shampoo etc.

- NO** Caps or spraying devices
- NO** Motor oil containers
- NO** Plastic bags, other numbers



Note: Plastic bottles and jugs must be separated and recycled by a 1 or 2 found inside a triangle on the bottom of the container; other numbers are not acceptable in the County's recycling program.

## MIXED OFFICE PAPER

-  Bond Paper/Letterhead
-  Photocopy Paper
-  Windowed Envelopes
-  Non-windowed Envelopes
-  Computer Paper
-  Colored Note Paper



- NO** Newspaper, food wrappers
- NO** Cardboard, paper towels
- NO** Glossy printed paper

Note: No need to shred, remove staples, tape, rubber bands or paper clips

## NEWSPAPER

-  Clean dry newspaper with inserts

- NO** Plastic bags or boxes

Note: Phonebooks may be recycled with the newspaper.

## MAGAZINES & CATALOGUES

-  Glossy printed paper, magazines and catalogs only



## CARDBOARD

-  Corrugated or paperboard (cereal, cracker, cake mix boxes)
-  Brown paper bags
-  Kraft envelopes, manila folders
-  Hard bound books

- NO** Metal bands
- NO** Plastic bags or packaging
- NO** Styrofoam or "peanuts"
- NO** Waxy-coated boxes

Note: Cardboard must be clean/dry.



## GLASS CONTAINERS

-  Green glass
-  Brown glass
-  Clear glass



- NO** Ceramic material, mirrors or light bulbs
- NO** Plate, windshield or window glass

Note: Glass must be separated and recycle by color; only glass food and beverage containers are acceptable.

## MIXED METAL CANS

-  Clean aluminum cans
-  Clean tin or steel cans with lids

- NO** Bags, boxes, or other metal items
- NO** Glass, plastic, paper, etc.



Note: Aluminum, tin, and steel cans may be placed in the bin together. Only food and beverage containers are acceptable. Labels may remain; please rinse.

**The Allegany County Recycling program does not recycle plastic bags, please check with your local stores.**

## USED MOTOR OIL & ANTIFREEZE



Collect used motor oil or antifreeze in clean unbreakable containers and bring them to a designated site. Please do not leave your empty containers. They are not recyclable.

## COMPOST

Located at 11700 PPG Road  
(Across from the former PPG Plant)  
Cumberland, MD 21502

**Summer hours:** Wednesday thru  
Sunday: 10:00 am to 6:00 p.  
(Begin the first Wednesday in April and end the Sunday after Thanksgiving.)

**Winter hours:** Tuesday, Thursday, &  
Saturday: 8:00 am to 4:00 pm

-  Brush
-  Grass & Leaves
-  Limbs (no larger than 4" in diameter)

- NO** Stumps, Roots, Rubble, Railroad Ties
- NO** Demolition Wood, Pallets, Garbage, Tires
- NO** Grass and or Leaves in Plastic Bags

Note: Mulch and compost may be taken from site free of charge. No equipment or personnel are available for loading.

## RESIDENTIAL APPLIANCES (WHITE GOODS)

White goods are household appliances and include: refrigerators, freezers, washers, dryers, dishwashers, stoves, air conditioners, water heaters, and dehumidifiers

## SPECIAL COLLECTIONS

-  Tires
-  Household Hazardous Waste
-  Electronics (eCycle)

## TIRES

-  Each tire requires 3 waste stickers
-  A maximum of 4 tires per resident per day is permitted.
-  Or Call 301-777-5933x 210 to schedule an appointment for disposal.

Note: Collection sites are in Oldtown, Flintstone and Orleans and by appointment with the Recycling Coordinator (site hours listed on other side of brochure).
