PRESENTATIONS

Item 1 – Allegany High School – Won Tournament of Bands Atlantic Coast Championship, held in Harrisburg, Pennsylvania, included more than 100 bands. Allegany led all Group 1 open bands with a score of 96.5 and placed first in all caption awards, including Best Music, Best Visual, Best Auxiliary, and Best Percussion.

Fort Hill High School – Won 1st Place in the 3A group at the Tournament of Bands Atlantic Coast Championships at Hershey Park Stadium. The band also won awards for Best Music and Best Visual. Fort Hill earned a historic high score of 95.93, breaking the school's highest score record for the third time in one season.

Mt. Ridge High School – Earned their first state title at the Maryland Marching Band Association State Championships at Towson University, with a score of 92.3 and receiving the award for Best Visual Performance. Their score set a new school record.
