UTV Minimum Standards
Date: 7/13/10

DEFINITION: A UTV is a 4 or 6 wheel vehicle designed for off road use. This unit has side by side seating for passengers.

RADIO DESIGNATION: UTV + Company number i.e. UTV 3

APPARATUS MINIMUM STANDARDS

- ___ Windshield.
- ___ Roll protection.
- ___ Seat belts for each riding position.
- ___ Head lights.
- ___ Allegany County mobile radio.
- ___ 2 1/2 lb. fire extinguisher.
- ___ First aid kit.
- ___ Hand lights – two (2).
- ___ Helmet with chin strap for each riding position.
- ___ Loaded unit shall not exceed the **GVWR** (Gross Vehicle Weight Rating). This includes personnel.
- ___ The unit shall be operated within the manufacturer’s riding capacity.
- ___ Documentation showing the units GVWR less personnel shall be on file at the fire station.

_____ Water tank, maximum 50 Gallons.

_____ 50' ½"-1" hose minimum.


_____ Class "A" foam system.

_____ Any additional equipment will be chosen by the fire department.

_____ All equipment must be secured to the unit.

_____ The water tank, hose and foam system are optional.

All UTV's placed in service after January 1, 2010 shall be inspected to this standard.
