Apparatus Numbering

Date: April 12, 2011

1. Purpose and Scope

- 1.1. **Purpose:** The purpose of this policy is to identify the **Apparatus Designations** within Allegany County
- 1.2. **Scope:** The Scope of this policy shall cover all Fire Apparatus in Allegany County.

2. Policy

2.1. Engines

- 2.1.1. All engines (including combination units) shall be identified using a 2 or 3 digit numbering system (depending on Company Number).
- 2.1.2. Radio designation shall include the unit name and number (i.e. Engine-Tanker 1-9-1) with each number being pronounced individually.

2.2. Special Services Apparatus

- 2.2.1. Apparatus will be identified by the unit name (i.e. Truck, Tower, Quint-Rescue, Squad, Mini-pumper, Utility, Brush, ATV, UTV, etc.)
- 2.2.2. Each unit shall be identified by the unit name followed by the Company Number (i.e. Truck 16).
 - 2.2.2.1. Duplicate Special Service Apparatus shall be identified using a 2 or 3 digit numbering system (i.e. Brush 7-1, Brush 7-2).

3. Designation

- 3.1. New apparatus placed in-service, will be designated by the current Fire Chief, in accordance with this policy and applicable apparatus standards.
- 3.2. Apparatus currently in-service may be changed at the discretion of the current Fire Chief, to become compliant with this policy.
 - 3.2.1. Once currently in-service apparatus has become compliant with this policy, it shall not be re-designated until such time as it is replaced or the units capability has changed (i.e. Engine becomes Engine-Rescue).

4. Administration

- 4.1. This policy will be reviewed and modified by the Allegany County Emergency Services Board, as needed.
- 4.2. This policy will be implemented immediately following adoption.
